"The ACCORD Mortality Results: Many Questions, But Few Answers"

The Action to Control Cardiovascular Risk in Diabetes (ACCORD) trial was stopped in February, 2008, due to a finding of increased mortality among participants in the intensive glycemia treatment group. This talk will describe results from post-hoc analyses of the associations between mortality and baseline characteristics, on-treatment glycosylated hemoglobin (A1C) levels and the occurrence of hypoglycemia in ACCORD.
